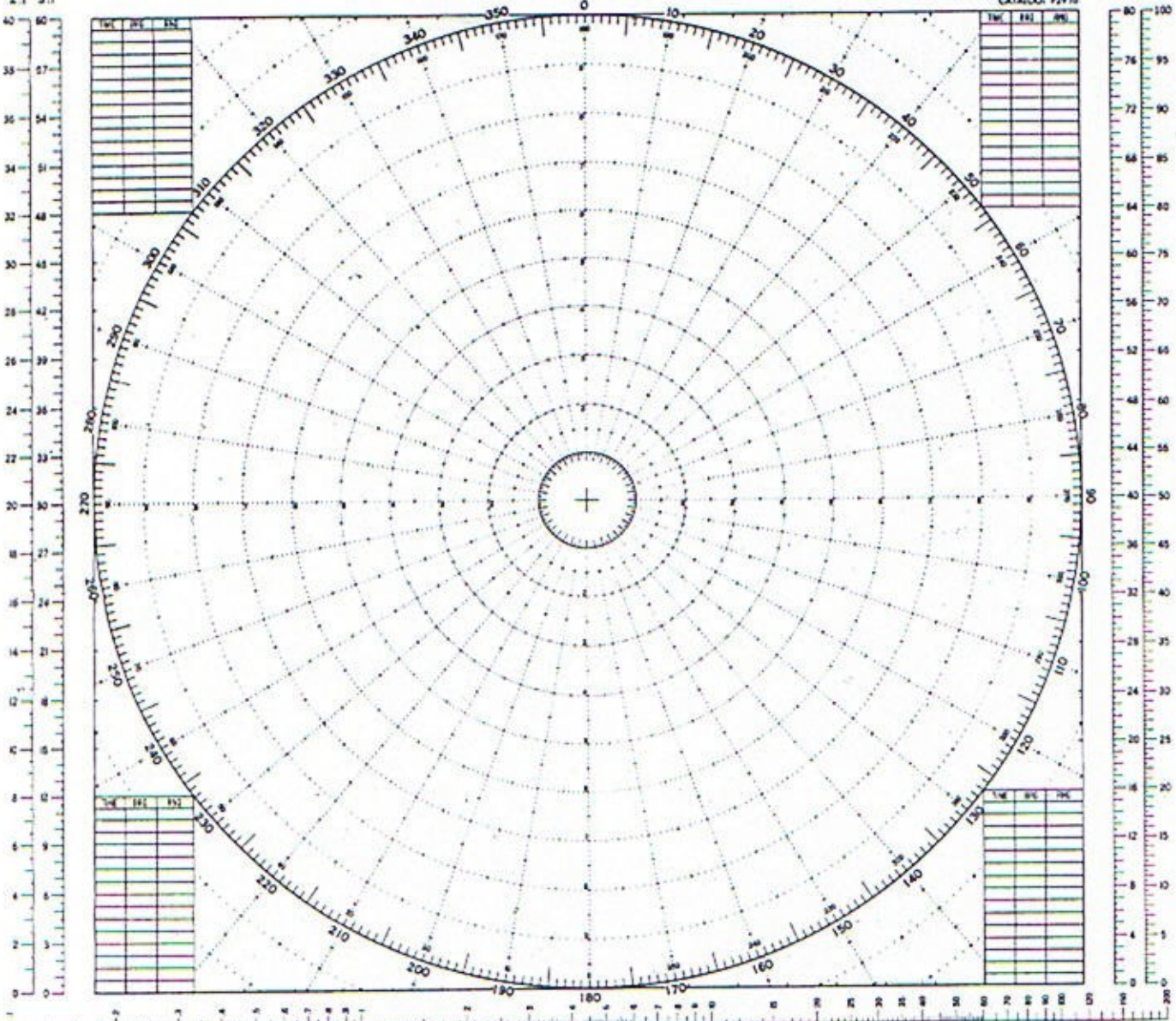


MANEUVERING BOARD

2:1 3:1

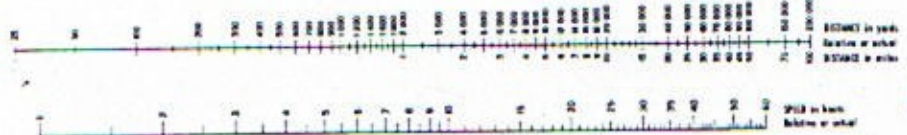

LOGARITHMIC TIME, SPEED, AND DISTANCE SCALE
Use of scales with logarithmic time, speed, and distance scale

TO FIND SPEED: place one point of compass on desired time and second point on distance scale without changing compass of dividers or without reworking of scale. Place first point on 60 second point on 60. Read value speed in knots.

TO FIND DISTANCE OR TIME: place one point of dividers on 60 and second point on speed in knots. Without changing compass of dividers or without reworking of scale, place first point on time scale and second point on 60. Read value distance in miles. Or place second point on distance in miles. First point will then indicate time.



USE OF 3-SCALE NOMOGRAM

Given any two corresponding quantities, solve for third by laying rule through points as proper scales and read intermediate as third value.
